top of Prospect Mountain or a 4-wheel drive excursion. There are art markets, horse shows, rodeos, car shows, quilt shows, music festivals, and winter events perfect for group enjoyment.

We offer performance venues for student groups as well as educational outings. For more active groups there are white-water-rafting trips, ghost tours, fly fishing lessons, guided hikes, rock climbing, horseback riding and more.
